Agreement with Redwood Christian Schools’ Philosophy of Educating Students

Redwood Christian Schools (RCS) believes that a student’s home and school should have a harmonious relationship. California State Immunization Requirements for School Entry:

- DTP (DTaP, DT, Td): 5 doses ****4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday**
- Tdap Booster: 1 shot on or after 7th birthday ****required when entering 7th grade regardless of age**
- Polio (TPOV, OPV, IPV): 4 doses ****3 doses OK if one was given after 4th birthday**
- Hepatitis B (HBV, Hep B): 3 doses
- Hepatitis A (HAV, Hep A): not required for school entry
- MMR (Measles-Mumps-Rubella): 2 series shots on or after 1st birthday
- Varicella (Chickenpox, Var, VZV, Varivax): 2 doses ****second dose after 13th birthday**

Greetings! Thank you for your interest in Redwood Christian Schools (RCS)! Our International Student Application is enclosed. If accepted, the student will be assessed upon arrival at RCS. Please return the completed application to the International Student Registrar of Redwood Christian Schools, 1000 Paseo Grande, San Lorenzo, CA, 94580 as soon as possible, along with a non-refundable application fee of \$495.00. If you need changes in an I-20 we have issued, there will be a \$50 fee.

After acceptance, the I-20 will be issued upon our receipt of:

1. Half tuition amount. (NOTE: No tuition refunds will be granted on request by the student or their parent/guardian/agent. Refunds only with visa denial two (2) times. Verification required. Remaining tuition due after visa obtained.
2. The \$200 SEVP I-90 fee. This fee is mandated by Congress to support the program office and the automated system that keeps track of students and ensures that they maintain their status while in the United States. (This can be done by RCS with the receipt of the \$200 fee or can be done by the student's family or agent.)
