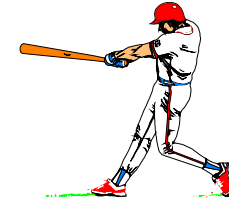
Campers will be given the opportunity to improve in all phases of the game with drills that emphasize proper fundamentals. Player safety is stressed at all times.
