## Transitional Kindergarten Supplies

*Please put your child's name on these supplies with a permanent marker:*

1. Labeled beach towel or blanket (no bigger than 3 feet by 5 feet) and a labeled pillowcase to hold the blanket: no pillows, sleeping bags, or mattresses, please.)
2. One (1) set of 8 watercolor paints palette
3. Two (2) horizontal pocket folders
4. Headphones in a Ziploc bag

*These items will be community use items – no name is necessary:*

- A. Three (3) boxes of washable Crayola markers (basic colors)
- B. One (1) box of crayons
- C. One (1) box of chubby pencils (Ticonderoga brand preferred)
- D. 1 pack of (4-8) glue sticks
- E. Two (2) regular boxes of facial tissue
- F. Four (4) tubs of Baby Wipes (refill packages are ok)
- G. Two (2) rolls of paper towels

Choose one additional item of your choice:

- \*Ziploc Bags of any size
- \*Small plastic cups
- \*Dixie cups
- \*Plastic forks or spoons

Please remember the following guidelines regarding these personal items:

- \*A backpack, roll case or book bag needs to be large enough to fit pocket folders and a lunch pail.
- \*Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support are to be worn all day.
- \*Girls, when wearing dresses, should wear play shorts underneath
- \*Kindergarten boys who are unable to snap, button, or zip their pants should wear pants with an elastic waist band.

## Kindergarten Supplies

*Please label items 1-7 with your child's name:*

1. Labeled beach towel or blanket (no bigger than 3 feet by 5 feet) and a labeled pillowcase to hold blanket: no pillows, sleeping bags, or mattresses, please
2. Backpack or book bag large enough for lunch box and folder
3. Three (3) folders with pockets at the bottom, not on the sides (cover pictures consistent with Christian values. Please, put name on the top right front).
4. Girls, when wearing dresses, should wear play shorts underneath
5. Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support are to be worn all day
6. One (1) plastic place mat with name on top
7. One (1) container of play dough (5 oz only) with name on lid and container
8. Headsets - personal ones not to be shared

*No name is necessary:*

- A. At least one (1) pair of scissors - Fiskars works well - (safety scissors often do not cut, but only bend the paper)
- B. At least twelve (12) pencils (Ticonderoga brand) - sharpened
- C. Three (3) boxes of at least 12 crayons (Crayola brand)
- D. At least one (1) box of facial tissue/Kleenex
- E. At least one (1) box or refill of wipes
- F. At least one (1) roll of paper towels
- G. At least twelve (12) clear glue sticks (regular size, not jumbo)

*To be shared:*

- i. One (1) box of at least 8 Crayola Broad Point Washable Markers
- ii. At least one (1) box dry erase markers - multi-colored
- iii. One (1) box Crayola colored Pencils - at least 24 count

Please keep a change of underwear and clothes in a plastic bag in their backpack, in case of an accident.

Note: Kindergarten boys who are unable to snap, button, or zip their pants should wear pants with an elastic waist band.

## 1st Grade Supplies

*The following items with an asterisk (\*) must be labeled with your child's name.*

1. Girls, when wearing dresses or skirts, must wear play shorts underneath all day.
2. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support to be worn all day
3. \*Three (3) pocket folders (Cover pictures must be compatible with Christian values.) These should be strong enough to stand when open (Please do not purchase plastic folders. They do not stand up).
4. Two (2) boxes of 24 crayons. No larger boxes please. No scented crayons. The crayons need to fit in their supply box.
5. Scissors with blunt tip (non plastic.) Fiskars work well.
6. \*Backpack or book bag large enough for supplies. Roll cases are not encouraged in K-1st.
7. Three (3) glue sticks
8. Two (2) pink erasers
9. Twelve (12) plain yellow no. 2 pencils. (Ticonderoga only) (Please sharpen them at home.)
10. \*One (1) small plastic pencil box (No metal boxes, please)
11. (1) one white Binder with Avery 1"-3 Ring Binder with Durable Clear Cover White.
12. (2) Two Composition Notebooks
13. One (1) set of skinny multicolor highlighters.
14. One (1) sets of eight to twelve thin tip colored markers of various colors.
15. One (1) package of 3x3 Post-It Notes (Please make sure the pack has lines on them)
16. Earbuds for use with iPads (labeled in a bag. To be kept at school.)
17. One (1) Red Pen (Erasable, if possible) for correcting.
18. One (1) box of tissue.
19. One (1) small container of Clorox Wipes.

*\*\*Parents may be asked to resupply crayons, glue sticks, eras-ers, and pencils as needed.*

## 2nd Grade Supplies

1. Two (2) school boxes (5" x 8") big enough for following supplies: pencils, eraser, crayons, scissors and glue (Make sure crayons can fit in supply box.) NO over-sized supply boxes please
2. Four (4) sturdy pocket folders. Cover picture compatible with Christian values, please These should be strong enough to stand when open. Besides providing storage for our papers, we will use them as walls between students at tables.
- ~~3. Two (2) boxes of 24 crayons~~
4. Two (2) boxes of markers (no large sets)
5. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day
6. Four (4) dozen #2 pencils, sharpened
7. Two (2) medium soft erasers and two (2) packs of small pencil top erasers
8. Four (4) glue sticks
9. Four (4) 2x2 post-its (4 different colors, at least 1 lined stack)
10. Five (5) skinny highlighters (pink, blue, yellow, orange, green)
11. Eight (8) black dry erase markers
12. Two (2) red pens for correcting
13. Two (2) composition notebooks
14. One (1) pack of wide-ruled binder paper
15. Scissors with blunt tips, non-plastic. Lat year's scissors are fine
16. English Standard Version (ESV) Bible (Old and New Testament)
17. One water bottle (NOT disposable)
18. Backpack, roll case, or book bag large enough for supplies
19. Two (2) regular boxes of facial tissues (200+ sheets)
20. Six (6) boxes of baby wipes
21. Two (2) rolls of paper towels
22. Earbuds

Please label only the following items with your child's name: school boxes, crayon boxes, marker boxes, earbuds, and scissors.

## 3rd Grade Supplies

1. Two (2) supply boxes approx. 5" X 8"
2. One (1) pocket folder with pockets on the bottom (cover compatible with Christian values)
3. One (1) 3-ring binder (1 1/2 inch rings)
4. One (1) wide-ruled package of binder paper (do not put in binder)
5. Twenty-four (24) #2 hardness sharpened pencils (labeled with first name and last initial)
6. Two (2) medium soft erasers
7. Six (6) glue sticks
8. Two (2) red ball-point pens
9. Scissors with blunt tips (not plastic, labeled)
10. Box of 24 crayons (labeled)
11. Box of 12 colored pencils (labeled)
12. Earbuds/headphones (no wireless)
13. English Standard Version (ESV) Bible with Old and New Testaments
14. Backpack, roll case or book bag large enough for all supplies
15. Girls, when wearing dresses or skirts, must wear play shorts underneath all day
16. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day
17. Two (2) large boxes of Kleenex for classroom supply
18. One (1) roll of paper towels
19. One (1) large package of "Wet Ones" or baby wipes
20. Two (2) of each color skinny highlighters: yellow, blue, pink, orange, green
21. Three (3) composition notebooks
22. Three (3) 2x2 inch sticky note pads

## 4th Grade Supplies

1. Seven (7) 2-pocket folders (Heavy Duty, if possible)
2. Five (5) reams of college-rules binder paper
3. Three (3) three-ringed binders - 1" with clear cover in front (No big fancy binders with zippers)
4. Three (3) sets of binder dividers
5. At least twenty four (24) #2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand recommended - they sharpen evenly and consistently unlike other brands, and we use them for standardized testing)
6. Four (4) medium soft erasers
7. Two (2) 12" ruler with inch, centimeter, and millimeter measurements (not flimsy plastic/flexible)
8. Two (2) pencil boxes (plastic only)
9. Six (6) glue sticks
10. Two (2) pairs of scissors with blunt tips (one per class)
11. Two (2) boxes of 24 crayons (no larger boxes - they do not fit in pencil boxes)
12. Two (2) sets of colored pencils (box of 12-24)
13. Two (2) sets of skinny multi-colored highlighters
14. Two (2) sets of thin tip colored markers of various colors (box of 8-12)
15. Eight (8) packages of 3x3 Post-It Notes (different colors). Please make sure 4 packs have lines on them.
16. Two (2) clipboards
17. Earbuds for use with iPads (labeled in a bag, to be kept at school)
18. Four (4) red pens (erasable, if possible)
19. Two (2) blue pens
20. Backpack (you don't need a giant one)
21. Lunch box
22. One (1) box of tissues
23. Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support to be worn all day
24. One (1) pack of baby wipes

### Note:

Students will bring home their text books to cover the first couple weeks of school. Paper grocery bags or thick wrapping paper protect books best. Please do not purchase the book co-vers that stick to books – the labels say they won't, but frequently this type ruins books by not being removable or leaving a sticky residue.

# Supply List

## 5th Grade Supplies

*All supplies should be replenished as needed throughout the year:*

1. 12" ruler with inch and millimeter markings (Make sure "0" point is easily identifiable. Don't get the flexible rubber rulers. Their markings are unreliable.)
2. Large plastic pencil bag
3. Four (4) #2 hardness pencils or mechanical pencils (.7mm or .5mm)  
(Buy extra lead for the mechanical pencils.)
4. Two (2) red pencils or pens (not markers)
5. Eraser (rectangular)
6. Scissors with blunt tips
7. Four (4) glue sticks or one (1) bottle school glue
8. ESV Bible
9. 500 sheets of 8 1/2" x 11" college-ruled, loose-leaf binder paper with smooth edges.  
(No spiral note-books or tear-out notebooks of lined paper.)
10. Individual manual pencil sharpener (with attached shavings holder)
11. Colored pencils (box of 12 or 24)
12. Multi-pack of highlighters (4 colors)
13. Earbuds for use with iPads (to be kept at school)
14. A reasonable quality stylus to be used on school iPads (to be kept at school)
15. Five (5) composition notebooks
16. Four (4) pocket folders (plain or with pictures consistent with RCS values)
17. Backpack, roll case or book bag large enough for supplies.
18. Two (2) regular boxes of facial tissue
19. One (1) box of baby wipes
20. One (1) roll of paper towels
21. One (1) roll of Scotch tape
22. Two (2) packages of sticky notes
23. One (1) package of whiteboard markers
24. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day
