



Elementary Supply List

Transitional Kindergarten Supplies

Please put your **child's name** on these supplies with a permanent marker:

1. Beach towel or blanket, (no bigger than 3 feet by 5 feet) and a labeled pillowcase to hold the blanket, travel sized pillow is optional
2. Two (2) sets of 8 [watercolor paints palette](#)
3. Two (2) [horizontal pocket folders](#)
4. Two (2) containers of [playdough](#) (big is better)
5. [Headphones](#) in a Ziploc bag

These items will be community use items – **no name is necessary:**

- One (1) box of [washable Crayola markers](#) (basic colors)
- One (1) box of [crayons](#)
- One (1) box of [chubby pencils](#) (Ticonderoga brand preferred)
- Eight (8) [glue sticks](#)
- Four (4) regular boxes of [facial tissue](#)
- Four (4) tubs of [Baby Wipes](#) (refill packages are ok)
- Two (2) rolls of [paper towels](#)

Choose one additional item of your choice:

- *[Ziploc Bags](#) of any size
- *[Small plastic cups](#)
- *[Dixie cups](#)
- *[Small paper plates](#)

Please remember the following [guidelines](#) regarding these personal items:

*A backpack, roll case or book bag needs to be large enough to fit pocket folders and a lunch pail.

*Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support are to be worn all day.

*Girls, when wearing dresses, should wear play shorts underneath

*TK boys who are unable to snap, button, or zip their pants should wear pants with an elastic waist band.

Kindergarten Supplies

Please label items 1-7 with your child's name:

1. Backpack large enough for lunch box, folder, and rest supplies
2. Rest Supplies: Beach towel or blanket (no bigger than 3 feet by 5 feet) and a pillowcase to hold blanket: *no pillows, sleeping bags or mattresses, please*
3. Three (3) [folders](#) with pockets at the bottom, not on the sides. Cover pictures consistent with Christian values. Please, put name on the top right front.
4. One (1) [plastic place mat](#) with name on top right front
5. One (1) 3 oz container of [Play-Doh](#) (if you can find 4 oz in the stores, please get that) with name on lid *and* container
6. One (1) [Headset](#) - Opened, labeled and placed in a labeled gallon-sized Ziploc bag
7. One (1) pair of [scissors](#) - Fiskars preferred - (safety scissors often do not cut well)

Do not label:

- Twenty-four (24) [pencils](#) (Ticonderoga brand) - sharpened preferred
- Three (3) boxes of 24 pack [crayons](#) (Crayola brand)
- 1 multi-pack Expo Dry Erase markers, [Fine Tip](#) or [Chisel Tip](#)
- One (1) box of [facial tissue](#)/Kleenex
- One (1) box or refill of baby [wipes](#)
- One (1) roll of [paper towels](#)
- Twelve (12) [glue sticks](#) (preferably white glue sticks like Scotch or Elmer's, but no clear or purple disappearing glue please – it doesn't stick well)
- Two large [polymer erasers](#)

Clothing:

- Send a change of underwear and clothes in a plastic bag, in case of an accident. We will store in our classroom.
- Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support are to be worn daily. If shoes have laces, your child should know how to tie their shoes.
- Girls, when wearing dresses, should wear play shorts underneath.
- Kindergartners who are unable to snap, button, or zip their pants should wear pants with an *elastic* waistband.

1st Grade Supplies

1. Three (3) [pocket folders](#) (Cover pictures must be compatible with Christian values.)
2. Two (2) boxes of 24 [crayons](#). No larger boxes please. No scented crayons. The crayons need to fit in their supply box.
3. [Scissors](#) with blunt tip (non-plastic.) Fiskars work well.
4. Twelve (12) Sharpened no. 2 [pencils](#). (Ticonderoga)
5. Three (3) medium soft [erasers](#) and two (2) packs of small pencil [top erasers](#)
6. One (1) small plastic [pencil box](#) (No metal boxes)
7. One (1) one white 1"-3 Ring [Binder](#) with Durable Clear Cover White.
8. Two (2) [Composition Notebook](#)
9. One (1) set of eight to twelve thin tip [colored markers](#) of various colors.
10. [Headphones](#) for use with iPads (labeled in a bag. To be kept at school.) No Earbuds!
11. One (1) [Red Pen](#) for correcting.

Last Name (N-Z)-One (1) box of [Facial Tissues](#) (200+)

2nd Grade Supplies

1. Two (2) [school boxes](#) (5" x 8") big enough for following supplies: pencils, eraser, crayons, scissors and glue (Make sure crayons can fit in supply box.) NO over-sized supply boxes please
2. Two (2) [sturdy pocket folders](#). Cover picture compatible with Christian values, please These should be strong enough to stand when open. Besides providing storage for our papers, we will use them as walls between students at tables.
3. Two (2) boxes of 24 [crayons](#)
4. Two (2) boxes of [markers](#) (no large sets)
5. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day
6. Four (4) dozen #2 [pencils](#), sharpened
7. Two (2) medium soft [erasers](#) and two (2) packs of small pencil [top erasers](#)
8. Two (2) [glue sticks](#)
9. Three (3) [4x4 post-its](#)
10. Five (5) skinny [highlighters](#) (pink, blue, yellow, orange, green)
11. Eight (8) black [dry erase markers](#)
12. Two (2) [red pens](#) for correcting
13. Three (3) [composition notebooks](#)
14. [Scissors](#) with blunt tips, non-plastic. Lat year's scissors are fine
15. English Standard Version (ESV) Bible (Old and New Testament)
16. One water bottle (NOT disposable)
17. Backpack, roll case, or book bag large enough for supplies
18. Two (2) regular boxes of [facial tissues](#) (200+ sheets)
19. Six (6) boxes of [baby wipes](#)
20. Two (2) rolls of [paper towels](#)
21. [Earbuds](#) or [Headphones](#)

4. One (1) wide-ruled package of [binder paper](#) (do not put in binder)
5. Twenty-four (24) #2 hardness sharpened [pencils](#) (labeled with first name and last initial)
6. Two (2) medium soft [erasers](#)
7. Six (6) [glue sticks](#)
8. Two (2) red ball-point [pens](#)
9. [Scissors](#) with blunt tips (not plastic, labeled)
10. Box of 24 [crayons](#) (labeled)
11. Box of 12 [colored pencils](#) (labeled)
12. [Earbuds](#) or [headphones](#) (no wireless)
13. Two (2) [large](#) boxes of [Kleenex](#) for classroom supply
14. One (1) roll of [paper towels](#)
15. Two (2) [large](#) package of "[Wet Ones](#)" or [baby wipes](#)
16. Two (2) of each color skinny [highlighters](#): yellow, blue, pink, orange, green
17. Three (3) [composition notebooks](#)
18. [English Standard Version \(ESV\) Bible](#) with Old and New Testaments
19. Backpack, roll case or book bag large enough for all supplies
20. Girls, when wearing dresses or skirts, must wear play shorts underneath all day
21. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day

4th Grade Supplies

1. Four (4) 2-pocket [folders](#) (Heavy Duty, if possible)
2. Two (2) packs of wide-ruled [binder paper](#)
3. One (1) [three-ringed binders](#) – 1 1/2" (No big fancy binders with zippers)
4. One (1) sets of [binder dividers](#) (5 tabs)
5. At least twenty four (24) #2 [pencils](#) PLEASE DO NOT LABEL
6. Three (3) medium soft [erasers](#)
7. One (1) [12" ruler](#) with inch, centimeter, and millimeter measurements (acrylic, not flexible)
8. One (1) [pencil boxes](#) (plastic only)
9. Three (3) [glue sticks](#)
10. One (1) pair of [scissors](#) with blunt tips (one per class)
11. One (1) box of 24 [crayons](#) (no larger boxes - they do not fit in pencil boxes)
12. One (1) box of [colored pencils](#) (box of 12-24)
13. Two (2) yellow [highlighters](#)
14. One (1) sets of thin tip [colored markers](#) of various colors (box of 8-12)
15. Two (2) packages of 3x3 [Post-It Notes](#).
16. One (1) [clipboards](#)
17. [Earbuds](#) or [Headphones](#) for use with iPads (labeled in a bag, to be kept at school)
18. Two (2) [red pens](#) (erasable, if possible)
19. One (1) [permanent, black, fine-tipped marker](#) (i.e. Sharpie)
20. Backpack (you don't need a giant one)
21. Lunch box
22. One (1) box of [tissues](#)
23. One (1) pack of [disinfecting wipes](#).
24. Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support to be worn all day

Note:

Students will bring home their text books to cover the first couple weeks of school. Paper grocery bags or thick wrapping paper protect books best. Please do not purchase the book covers that stick to books – the labels say they won't, but frequently this type ruins books by not being removable or leaving a sticky residue.

5th Grade Supplies

All supplies should be replenished as needed throughout the year:

1. [12" ruler](#) with [inch and millimeter](#) markings (Make sure "0" point is easily identifiable. Don't get the flexible rubber rulers. Their markings are unreliable.)
2. Large [pencil bag](#)
3. [Eraser](#) (rectangular)
4. [Scissors](#) with blunt tips
5. ESV Bible
6. Individual manual [pencil sharpener](#) (with attached shavings holder)
7. [Colored pencils](#) (box of 12 or 24)
8. Multi-pack of [highlighters](#) (5 colors)
9. [Earbuds](#) or [Headphones](#) for use with iPads (to be kept at school)
10. A reasonable quality [stylus](#) to be used on school iPads (to be kept at school)
11. Five (5) 100-sheet [composition notebooks](#)
12. Four (4) [pocket folders](#) (plain or with pictures consistent with RCS values)
13. Backpack, roll case or book bag large enough for supplies.
14. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day

Please do NOT label these items:

15. Four packages (4) #2 hardness [pencils](#)
16. Two (2) [pens](#) (not markers)
17. Two (2) [bottle school glue](#)
18. Two (2) regular boxes of [facial tissue](#)
19. One (1) box of [baby wipes](#)
20. One (1) roll of [paper towels](#)
21. One (1) package of [sticky notes](#)
22. 500 sheets of 8 1/2" x 11" college-ruled, loose-leaf [binder paper](#) with smooth edges. (No spiral notebooks or tear-out notebooks of lined paper.)
